

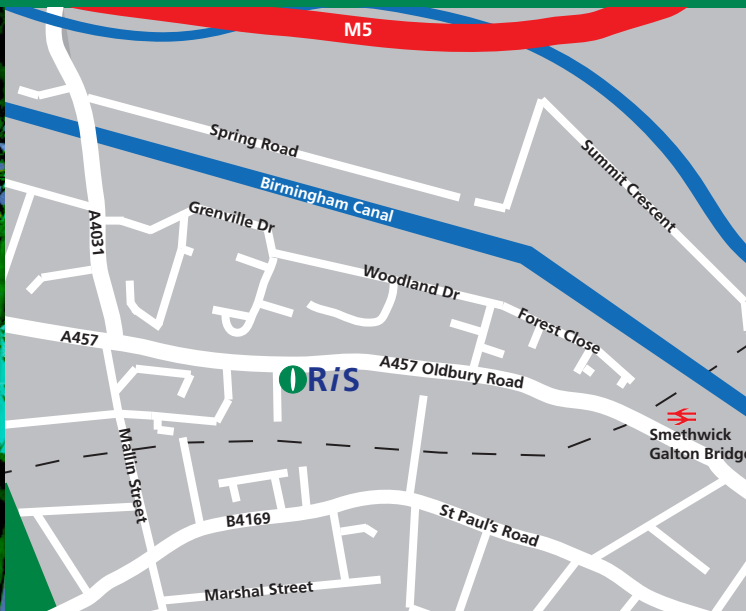
IRiS Sandwell is delivered by Cranstoun in partnership with Inclusion and Kaleidoscope⁺.

Who is IRiS Sandwell for?

Our services are available to anyone over the age of 18 who lives in the Metropolitan Borough of Sandwell and is experiencing difficulties with drugs and/or alcohol. We also have services available for family members of drug and alcohol users who need support.

How Can I Access IRiS?

You can access our service simply by coming in and seeing us at the Alberta Building, attending one of our satellite locations or by giving us a call. You will be greeted by a member of staff who will explain what the next steps will be and they will arrange for you to see a key worker.

If you have a professional from another service working with you, they can refer you by ringing us directly or by downloading the referral form from our website and emailing it to sandwellreferrals@irispartnership.org.uk or faxing it to 0121 358 9630. We will then contact you and arrange an appointment.

You can also be referred via:

- GP Surgeries & Hospitals
- Mental Health Services
- Homelessness Services
- Criminal Justice System – police, courts etc.
- Your friends & family

If getting to our services is difficult for you due to disability or mobility issues, anxiety or mental health issues, we can arrange visits to your home or other locations. Just let us know!
